Peace WITH God (Vertical Peace)

Romans 5:1 AMP Therefore, since we have been justified [that is, acquitted of sin, declared blameless before God] by faith, [let us grasp the fact that] we have peace with God [and the joy of reconciliation with Him] through our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed).

[7] And the ace of God [that peace which reassures the heart, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] nds guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [is yours].

Ge ab [wl	Peace BETWEEN People (Horizontal Peace) hesians 2:14-15 AMP For He Himself is our peace and our bond of unity. He who made both groups—[Jews and ntiles]—into one body and broke down the barrier, the dividing wall [of spiritual antagonism between us], [15] by olishing in His [own crucified] flesh the hostility caused by the Law with its commandments contained in ordinances nich He satisfied]; so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thereby establishing peace.
