The Gospel of John: The Deity and Teaching of Jesus Christ

***“Revealed by Christ, Received in Faith, Secured for His Glory”***

John 17:6-10 NKJ

[6] "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. [7] Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. [8] For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me. [9] "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. [10] And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.

### Main Points

1. ***The Father Revealed by the Son*** (v. 6) You cannot know God apart from Jesus Christ.

2. ***The Word Received and Believed*** (vv. 7–8) Saving faith responds to God’s revelation.

3. ***The Believers Secured and Glorifying Christ*** (vv. 9–10) Believers are secure in Christ and called to reflect His glory.

**Instruction** (2 Tim 3:16): What is God telling me?

**Inspiration** (Romans 8:16): How is the Holy Spirit moving me?

**Imitator of Christ** (Ephesians 5:1): How will I serve God by imitating Jesus?

**My prayer this week:**

Father, thank You for making Yourself known through Jesus; strengthen my faith to receive Your truth, keep Your Word, and glorify You with my life.

**Discussion Questions:**

1. Jesus says He has *revealed* the Father's name to His disciples. What does it mean for Jesus to "reveal" God — and how does He still do that today?
2. Jesus says the disciples *kept* the word He gave them. What does "keeping" God's word look like in real, everyday life?
3. Jesus prays specifically *for* His disciples, not for the world at this moment. What does this reveal about His priorities and His relationship with them?
4. This passage highlights both divine initiative ("You gave them to Me") and human response ("they have kept Your word"). How do you see these two realities working together in your own walk with God?

**Bible Reference NKJV**

**John 14:8-9 NKJV** Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." [9] Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

**John 1:18 NKJV** No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

**John 6:39-40 NKJV** This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. [40] And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

**John 6:44 NKJV** No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

**John 15:19 NKJV** If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

**1 Peter 2:9 NKJV** But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

**John 15:16 NKJV** You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

**Ephesians 1:3-4 NKJV** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, [4] just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

**2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 NKJV** But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, [14] to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**John 10:27-30 NKJV** My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. [28] And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. [29] My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. [30] I and My Father are one."

**John 6:37 NKJV** All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

**John 14:23-24 NKJV** Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. [24] He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

**John 8:31-32 NKJV** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. [32] And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

**Deuteronomy 7:6-7 NKJV** "For you are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. [7] The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples;

**John 3:35 NKJV** The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

**John 13:3 NKJV** Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,

**John 7:16 NKJV** Jesus answered them and said, "My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

**John 8:25-30 NKJV** Then they said to Him, "Who are You?" And Jesus said to them, "Just what I have been saying to you from the beginning. [26] I have many things to say and to judge concerning you, but He who sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I heard from Him." [27] They did not understand that He spoke to them of the Father. [28] Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. [29] And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him." [30] As He spoke these words, many believed in Him.

**Hebrews 1:1-2 NKJV** God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, [2] has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

**Romans 10:17 (NKJV)** "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

**John 15:15 NKJV** No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

**John 12:49-50 NKJV** For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. [50] And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak."

**John 8:28 NKJV** Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.

**John 1:12-13 NKJV** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: [13] who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

**John 6:69 NKJV** Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.

**John 8:42 NKJV** Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.

**John 3:17 NKJV** For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

**John 20:31 NKJV** but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

**John 14:6 NKJV** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

**Romans 8:34 NKJV** Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

**Hebrews 4:14-16 NKJV** Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. [15] For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. [16] Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

**Hebrews 9:24 NKJV** For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us;

**John 3:16 NKJV** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**John 1:29 NKJV** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

**John 15:19 NKJV** If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

**John 6:37 NKJV** All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

**John 10:11,14 NKJV** "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. [14] I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own.

**Isaiah 43:7 NKJV** Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him."

**1 Corinthians 10:31 NKJV** Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

**John 10:30 NKJV** I and My Father are one."

**John 16:15 NKJV** All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.
