## "The True Shepherd and His Voice"

John 10:1-6 NKJV

[1] "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does	NOTES
not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs	
up some other way, the same is a thief and a	
robber. [2] But he who enters by the door is the	
shepherd of the sheep. [3] To him the	
doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice;	
and he calls his own sheep by name and leads	
them out. [4] And when he brings out his own	
sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep	
follow him, for they know his voice. [5] Yet they	
will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee	
from him, for they do not know the voice of	
strangers." [6] Jesus used this illustration, but	
they did not understand the things which He	
spoke to them.
