Psalm 98:4-6 AMP "Shout joyfully to the LORD, all the earth; Shout [in jubilation] and sing for joy and sing praises. [5] Sing praises to the LORD with the lyre, With the lyre and the sound of melody. [6] With trumpets and the sound of the horn Shout with joy before the King, the LORD."
